This past summer, the RCAF Trenton Power and Sail Squadron and the CFB Trenton Yacht Club, celebrated their 50th Anniversary with a weekend of festivities and on-thewater events. A dinner dance followed complete with a great reunion of past members and friends. A great time was had by all.

The organizing committee did a superb job under the direction of Commodore Denis Dove and our Treasurer, John Fear such that we ended up with a surplus of over \$300 after all the bills were paid, even though we had a very nominal charge for the various events. So what to do with the surplus?

It was the decision of both the Yacht Club and the Power Squadron to donate the funds to Quinte Sailability to purchase the leg-separating-lifting-harness shown above. This expensive harness is used by Quinte Sailability to lift disabled sailors into their especially equipped sail boats to go sailing.

Quinte Sailability is a sailing school for persons with a physical or developmental disability, regardless of age or degree of disability. Founded in 2001 and serving the greater Quinte area the school has grown to be one of the largest in Ontario. It operates out of the CFB Trenton Yacht Club.

In 1998 Don Barber won many Sail Races at the Yacht Club but better than that, he was married to the Yacht Club Bar Officer, Janet.

Rodger Beck was an important instructor for the navigators on the Squadron for several years. In 2001 a winner was Tom Ross. Did you notice that his boat was one of the volunteer boats and he has done that a lot over the years. In 2003 Dennis Dove won the Grad Cup and served as Fleet Captain Power & wrote competitions. He was also Vice- Commodore and currently our Yacht Club Commodore. This year 2012, the Squadron Executive Officer is Ken Mugford who will be our Commander at our next AGM. He also volunteered his boat for various events for the Squadron and helps me a lot to understand my computer.

PCOC Course Goes On-Line

The Canadian Power and Sail Squadrons are now offering the Boating Basics course for the PCOC card, on-line. The course is very well designed with interactive slides to cover the material and quizzes after each section to reinforce learning, with videos to illustrate important points. When the student has completed the course, there is an opportunity to sit the exam on-line. The time spent on the course material is monitored, and a minimum total of 3 hours is required.

A big advantage of putting the course on-line is that it is available whenever our clients want it, no more waiting for a classroom course to be scheduled. It is also a fine introduction to CPS education, and our hope is that people who take the Boating Basics online will sign up for the new Boating Essentials classroom course the following September. The Boating Essentials course is a revised shorter Boating course that covers charting and seamanship topics that are not part of the PCOC curriculum.

Our squadron plans to continue running traditional classroom Boating Basics courses, subject to demand. However, on-line education is becoming extremely popular in today's information society, and we expect the instant availability of the on-line course to be a big feature in its favour.
