Boating Courses Scheduled

The RCAF Trenton Squadron will be conducting the **Maritime Radio Seminar** for all Yacht Club members, Boating Course students and others who wish to obtain their Restricted Operator's Certificate (Maritime), ROC (M), with DSC (Digital Selective Calling) endorsement. The Seminar will be conducted over two evenings on March 7th & 8th 2011 starting at 19:00 hrs, or 7:00 PM, in the Yacht Club lounge. The examination for both modules will be conducted on Monday March 14th at 19:00 hrs (7:00 PM).

This course is mandatory for everyone who will be operating a Maritime VHF or MF Radio in Canadian waters.

A **Boat Pro course** is scheduled for April 4th and 5th also in the Yacht Club lounge and starts at 19:00 hrs (7PM). The examination will be held on Monday 11 April 2011. A second Boat Pro course is scheduled for May 9 and 10 with the exam on the 16th. This course is required for those who have not yet obtained their PCOC card which is mandatory for any person operating any powered recreational vessel after 15 September 2009.

Also watch the Yacht Club Bulletin Boards for seminars on Electronic Charting and Radar in the spring.
