The second session was Knots, Bends & Hitches for tying up your Boat presented by Sean Lewis on March 8<sup>th</sup> with another 8 persons attending. Third session was the Marine Electrical Maintenance presented by Chris Flynn on March 15<sup>th</sup> with 14 persons attending. The next 3 Wednesday evening sessions are presented by Agathe Gaulin and offer the Boating 2- Beyond PCOC course content in workshop format. 10 persons attended the March 23<sup>rd</sup> session and 8 attended the March 30<sup>th</sup> session; including a couple from Ladysmith who are signed up for the Boating 2 certification and who will be tutored by Nigel Wells.
