### **Qualifications for Membership**

A Member of CPS-ECP is an individual who is at least 19 years of age and who:

- has successfully completed a course prescribed by the Board of Directors; or
- holds a valid Pleasure Craft Operator Certificate (PCOC)

A Prescribed Course is any CPS-ECP course or equivalent as per the Competency Equivalence Table:

An Associate is an individual who is less than nineteen (19) years of age but meets all of the other requirements of becoming a Member, and has applied to be an Associate. Any Associate who reaches age nineteen (19) may apply to become a Member. Please note: while being an Associate means having all of the privileges of membership, except for voting rights and signing authority, an Associate is not a member of CPS-ECP

### **Membership fees**

- \$35.00 – Within 30 business days of completing a CPS-ECP course, first year and never been a member of Canadian Power and Sail Squadrons.
- \$60.00 – First year and never been a member of Canadian Power and Sail Squadrons.
- \$52.00 – Yearly Membership renewal, Family Head.
