





Fall Boating 2/3:

Our hybrid class worked out better than expected. We had the use of Nicole Neuman's company boardroom with webcam and video conferencing system, so that students could join the class virtually or sit in person. Those who joined virtually had a full view of the classroom, as well as the power point slides. Materials were a bit slow to get to us, but everyone seemed to have what they needed. We had 11 registered and 4 past registrants

completing the course now. Classes are also recorded on zoom to the cloud. (my zoom account)

The feedback received from students/proctors/instructors was generally positive with hands on instruction being well received and much more effective. The pub gatherings at the Golden Parrots after the class time (around 8:30pm) also appears to be a hit!

Spring Boating 2/3:

The new Boating 2/3 course is being held at Moody Middle School on Buller Street in Port Moody. Hopefully, this will facilitate breaking into small groups with proctors and therefore relationships with the students. Plus, the rental is substantially less than it used to be when we held the classes at PMSS. PMSS does not allow classroom rentals any longer.

There will be no printed manuals for this course or upcoming B2/3 courses. The manuals are 10 years old now and there is no plan to print updated ones.

The course will be all online via the Moodle platform which can be easily updated and added any extra information or videos, etc. We will be using the Version 4 for the Spring course as the latest Version 5 Boating Navigation and Boating Handling (BNBH) has many changes eliminating some topics and shortened (9 – 10 weeks).

VHF: Lynn Meisl held an in class VHF course Jan.8 with 7 students -4 of them from the Fall B 2/3 course. Chris and I helped Lynn. It was held at Synergy Engineering boardroom. Future VHF classes will be held at Moody Middle School.

North Shore Squadron is holding in person classes, simulcast with Online class as well as zooming in other squadrons classes who may not have enough instructors. In the fall, North Shore Squadron zoomed-in a class on Bowen Island.



PMD Government & Industry Liaison

Canadian Hydrographic Service (CHS) has advised that Sailing Directions will be modernized for 2024 publication. Old imagery of ports and navigation passages will be updated in color. Paper chart appearance will also reflect certain changes (no details to date).

Transport Canada has reported numerous incursions by pleasure craft into the Southern Resident Killer Whale sanctuary zones. Monitoring and enforcement will likely be stepped up for 2024. Boaters are reminded that the minimum approach distance to all whales is 400 metres; effective for the full year.

Boaters on the Fraser River should watch for advisories/closures this spring in connection with the new Patullo Bridge.

Good news! Fish Safe BC reports that more commercial fishermen are now accepting and wearing PFD's (inflatable type).

World Maritime Day is proposed for some time at the end of September, likely in conjunction with the BC Sea Festival. Opportunities for CPS involvement may be possible.
